 - a. Inspections; Council members discussed The Benton County Risk Reduction Program. Ald.  - a. Road damage due to flooding Woods Lodge & Rader Road
 - i. Ald. Sullivan and Mayor Whitehorn updated council on the ditch/culvert work being done on Woods Lodge and Rader Road. Mayor Whitehorn requested additional funds to finish this project. A motion was made by Ald. Sullivan to approve an additional \$15,000 (fifteen thousand dollars) to finish the ditch/culvert work being done on Woods Lodge and Rader Road. Ald. Hansen amended the motion to\$20,000 (twenty thousand dollars) and seconded the motion to finish the ditch/culvert work being done on Woods Lodge and Rader Road. Discussion; Mayor Whitehorn informed council he has spent \$34,166.62 (thirty- four thousand, one hundred, sixty-six dollars and sixty-two cents) to date. At the last council meeting, the Mayor was approved to spend \$30,000 (thirty thousand dollars). He used his discretionary funds for the remainder \$4,166.62 (four thousand, one hundred, sixty-six dollars and sixty-two cents). Roll call: Ald. Miller; yes, Ald. Hansen; yes, Ald. Sullivan; yes, Ald. King; yes, and Ald. O'Dell; yes. All approved. Motion carried. Ald. Sullivan requested Rec/Tres. Barnes to contact Tim Gehring with Arkansas Department of Emergency Management to set a time to come and inspect finished work and close out FEMA file.
