 - a. 411 Sheppard Road; Mayor Whitehorn updated council on the progress of the clean-up of this property. States they have made some noticeable progress. Attorney McClure will hold off with any further legal action until he is advised from Mayor Whitehorn.

 - a. None
- 3. Streets Ald. King
 - Safety lights for town truck; Ald. Alvarenga is waiting on pricing and will update council at the May council meeting.
 - b. Mayor Whitehorn had been questioned by landowner who owns land near the Dollar General Store in Avoca. The road was attempted to be dedicated and donated to Avoca in 2014 by Marion and Patricia Holland, husband and wife—however, their attempt to donate to the town lacked words of conveyance (grant, bargain, sell and convey) and would not effectively donate the property to Avoca. Further, upon investigation by Town Attorney Edwin N. McClure and confirmation by way of a Title Report from PCI Advance Title, it appears subsequent conveyances of the property in question were granted to at least two others since the attempted donation by the Holland. As such, this property is not property owned by Avoca.
- 4. Park Ald. Hansen
 - a. Trail Lights; Rec/Tres. Barnes informed council the light fixtures have been delivered and the poles are scheduled to arrive around the first of May.
 - b. Ald. Rollins asked about the "No Long-Term Parking" signs that are posted in the Steam Whistle park. Rec/Tres. Barnes asked if she would like to amend the agenda due to park signs not being listed. Ald. Rollin replied yes. Mayor Whitehorn explained to Ald. Rollins, the signs are posted so cars are not parked and left there for long periods of time.

Old Business

- 1. Town Hall Buzzer; Rec/Tres. Barnes informed council, ADT would install a security door controller and key fobs for the installation fee of two-thousand and eight-two dollars and sixty-eight cents (\$2082.68), and a monthly monitoring fee of thirty-nine dollars and fifty-nine cents (\$39.59). Ald. Rollins made a motion to not approve the extra security for the town hall. Motion failed due to no second. Ald. Hansen made a motion to approve the extra security for the town hall. Ald. King seconded the motion. Discussion: held concerning cost. Rec/Tres. Barnes was asked to contact ADT concerning cost. Ald. Hansen amended her motion to table this topic until the May 2021 council meeting. Seconded by Ald. King. All approved, motion carried.
- 2. Trash Cans; Mayor Whitehorn has tried contacting Waste Management many times, as had a few elderly residents concerning the delivery of trash can. He has had no response back. He will continue to try and get ahold of someone at Waste Management concerning this issue.

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New Business

1. Bike Races; 2021 Racing Series; Ben Craig talked to council members concerning bike races in the town limits of Avoca. Ald. King made a motion to allow these bike races. Seconded by Ald. Rollins. Discussion; held concerning the pros and cons of these races. Roll call; Ald. Hansen: no, Ald. Rollins: yes, Ald. Alvarenga no, Ald. Oakes: yes, and Ald. King: yes. Motion carried.
