- b. Stripping: Mayor Whitehorn state he will call to have the stripping done on Rader, Old Wire, Woods Lodge, Smith Ridge and Pearl.
- c. Guard Rail along Prairie Creek Road; Rec/Tres. Barnes states she received an estimate from Time Stripping for the cost of \$12,600.00 (twelve thousand, six hundred dollars and zero cents) for 300 feet of guardrail from Time Stripping, Inc. Ald. Alvarenga will contact Franklin Miller concerning his portion of the fee. Ald. King made a motion, for the town to pay Time Stripping the full cost of \$12,600.00 (twelve thousand, six hundred dollars and zero cents) for 300 feet of guardrail to go along Prairie Creek Road, and to have Franklin Miller reimburse the Town of Avoca his half of the cost of \$6,300.00 (six thousand, three hundred dollars and zero cents).
